OFFICIAL AIRPORT ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE: Athens International Airport Eleftherios Venizelos, Athens, Greece

GROUND TRANSPORTATION: The Organizing Committee will provide transportation to and from the airport as well as between the hotel and venue.

GENERAL INFORMATION

<u>ACCREDITATIONS:</u> **On the first day of training**, the members of each team will receive their **accreditations cards** from the accreditation room after their identification.

<u>CHANGES TO COACH CARDS:</u> The changes to the coach cards can be madeuntil the day before each event at 17:00. No coach cards signing procedure willbe taking place.

<u>OPENING CEREMONY:</u> The opening ceremony will be at the competition pool on Wednesday, June 25, at 17:30. One athlete per country must be ready at the protocol area at 17:00 (details TBC at the technical meeting on June 24).

<u>TRAINING – WARM UP SESSION:</u> Schedule for training with music will be arranged based on number of events entered, after considering the number of federations, date and time of arrivals and will be announced soon.

Teams are allowed to share music time. Program of share music will be arranged between team managers and it will be announced to the LOC 30 minutes before training with music. Please respect the specifications both for the warm up and competition area.

FLOW OF THE COMPETITION: At the end of the warm-up period athletes are asked to go in the Last Call Room three routines prior to their start number. Routine numbers one, two and three must report to Last Call Room 10 minutes before the start of the event. All athletes must present their accreditation card at the Last Call Room prior to their event. A member of the organizing committee will verify the credentials against the start list. The accreditation cards will be given back to the coach, who will be taking care of them during the routine. Athletes will collect their accreditation card from their coach when leaving the Field of Play (details TBC at the technical meeting on June 24).

KISS & CRY AREA: A maximum of two team coaches/officials per national Federation will be permitted on the Field of Play during Competition. Coaches of each routine will wait for their athletes in kiss & cry area during competition.

<u>VICTORY CEREMONIES:</u> The victory ceremonies will be held right after finals. The presentation of medals, the national anthem of the gold medalist will be played, and the national flags of medalists will be shown at the scoreboard. Athletes are reminded to attend all victory ceremonies in their official National Federation tracksuit with appropriate footwear.

Medals will be awarded for 1st – 3rd places in all events.

OFFICIAL DINNER: 1 Dinner for European Aquatics Office, EA Officials and Federations – Details TBC soon.

<u>CHANGING ROOMS:</u> Each country has to use their own changing rooms. There will be names on each door.

<u>MEDICAL SERVICE INFORMATION & DOPING CONTROL:</u> Medical service will be available during the stay of the teams in Athens; it will be available at training and competition facilities.


Doping controls will be according to the **European Aquatics Medical Guidelines** and the **WADA International Standards**.


Full board will include **three meals per day**, from dinner on the day of check-in (depending on arrival time) to breakfast on the day of departure (depending on departure time).
